Identifies potential transit stop enhancements, biking & pedestrian improvements, & public space & creative placemaking activation.

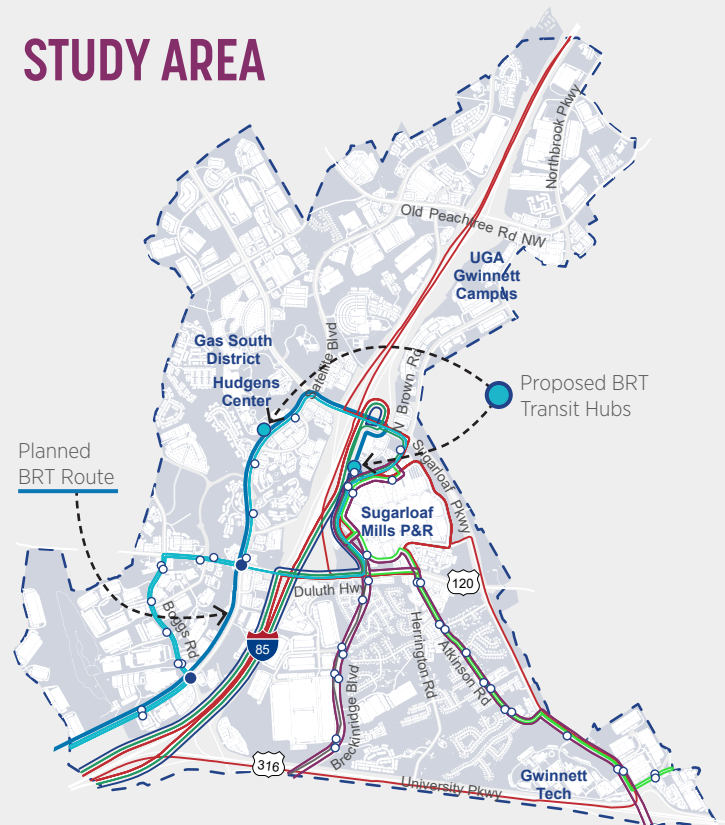
JAN - APR 2022
