### **Minutes**

Chairman Morgan called to order the Board retreat of the Sugarloaf Community Improvement District Board of Directors at 9:00 a.m. Kathy Keeley of the Georgia Center for Nonprofits facilitated the retreat session.

Ms. Davis introduced one topic of CID business by circulating two new price estimates for gateway signage and requesting feedback from the Board. After a brief discussion on the signage, Ms. Keeley started the retreat session with introductions and a discussion of trends.
